Your Titan watch has been manufactured in one of the most modern facilities in the world. In the process of manufacture, each component and the complete watch have been subjected to a series of strict quality checks. We are therefore able to Warranty your watch against manufacturing defects for a period of 2 years from the date of original retail purchase, subject to the following terms and conditions.

Terms and Conditions of Warranty

Subject to the exceptions listed below, your watch has a warranty for a period of two years from the date of original purchase.

This warranty does not cover the following:

- Normal wear and tear.
- Damage caused by mishandling, including damage to mineral glass or acrylic crystal and strap or bracelet.
- Damage caused by the watch being opened anywhere other than a Titan Customer Service Centre.
- Damage due to water entry in a watch which is not marked "water-resistant".
- All finishes and plating, including gold plating.
- Any consequential damage or loss arising on account of the aforesaid.
- Battery.

HANDLING AND CARE

Protection and Cleaning

Your Titan watch is precision instrument and has been built with a great deal of care. It is not advisable to subject it to severe impact, rough usage, exposure to caustic substances, extreme temperatures or strong magnetic fields.

Clean your watch periodically, by using a soft slightly damp cloth to gently wipe off any dust, moisture or sweat. This is especially important for gold electroplated watches and metal bracelets. Do not use any solvents, commercial cleaners, detergents, adhesives, paint or cosmetic spray.

Water resistance

The extent of water resistance for which your Titan watch is designed is marked on the back of the watch.

If your watch is not marked "Water resistant", then you must take care not to get your watch wet as it may damage the watch.

If marked "Water resistant", your watch can withstand upto 30 meters of pressure and is suitable for contact with splashes of water or rain, but not for diving.

Before using a water resistant watch in water, ensure that the crown is pushed in completely. Do not operate the crown when the watch is wet. If used in sea water, clean the watch in fresh water and dry it completely with soft cloth.

Should water or condensation appear in your watch, it is important that you take your watch to an Authorised Titan Service Centre as soon as possible, to minimize internal damage.

Note: Pressure in meters indicates test pressure and does not correspond to actual diving depth, since swimming and diving movements add pressure on the watch.

Battery

When your watch begins to lose time, or the second hand is erratic, you should arrange to have the battery replaced as soon as possible, to avoid damage to the watch.

Repairs

Your watch contains complex precision components. Do not open or allow any unauthorized person to open the watch, as you will invalidate the conditions of the warranty and possibly cause damage to the watch. In case of any malfunction, take your watch promptly to an Authorised Titan Service Centre.

- b. Guarantee Card
